Pullers

The course is set so members can pull for themselves in a group. Members may arrange for a puller in advance by calling the office. Westside also offers the Clay Delay system and a Ventriloquist System for individual shooters to pull their own targets.

Afterwards your group is welcome to relax in the clubhouse or pavilion with a cold drink. For larger groups, Westside recommends a tournament day. All amenities can be provided. The Westside Events Manager will work with you to make sure your event is enjoyable and a complete success.

Westside is the perfect place to entertain for business or raise funds for your favorite charity. Groups ranging from 20 to over 600 can be accommodated. The 5000 square-foot open barn looking out across a half-acre pond to the sporting clay course is the perfect place. Shooting Instruction

Adam Blair is a NSCA Level II instructor and is available Monday – Sunday for private or group lessons at your convenience. Laurie Daniel is a Level I instructor and is available upon request. Westside has additional talented NSCA Certified Instructors on call. All instruction is available at reasonable rates and is open to anyone.

Directions:

From Houston, take I-10 West to Katy. Take the Pederson Rd. Exit 737. Turn right (north) on Pederson to Hwy 90 and go 0.3 of a mile to 2855. Turn right on 2855 and go 6.2 miles to the stop sign at 2855 and 539. Cross 529 and go an additional 0.9 mile. Turn left and go 0.9 mile to the intersection of Morrison and Pattison. Turn right on Pattison Rd and go 1.9 miles. Look for the lone Pine tree on the right. Turn right at the private drive and continue approximately 1 mile to the club house.

WESTSIDE SPORTING GROUNDS is a private sporting facility formed and operated for the enjoyment of members, their families and guests, each of whom are required to abide by the House Rules as provided herein. Ultimate responsibility for compliance with rules lies with the member.

HOUSE RULES

REGISTRATION

1. All members and guests must register in the Club Office and guests must sign a waiver prior to participating in any activities.
2. Members are responsible for reporting all expenses they or their guests incur. The Sporting Clay counters give an accurate count for the targets used on the course. The Ball Trap, 5- Stand, ZZ's and any additional games are on the honor system. Please accurately report all targets thrown when checking out in the Club Office. Members may add guest targets to their bill or elect to pay outright for these targets. Westside accepts Visa, Master Card, Checks and Cash.

GENERAL RULES

1. The appearance of your club is important to all members and guests to insure they have a pleasant visit. **All shooters are required to pick up their hulls.** Please do not dispose of any litter (i.e., cans, bottles, paper, cigarettes, cigars, shotgun shell hulls, etc.) except in receptacles provided. Each station is equipped with a trashcan and hull bucket. **No hulls should be left on the ground after shooting.**
2. Use of the phone and wi-fi are permitted. No long-distance phone call can be made without providing a credit card for billing.
3. Guns of others are not to be handled except with the owner's express permission.
4. Members, their family and/or guests are responsible for any and all damage caused to Westside property or equipment. Westside takes no responsibility for any personal injury or loss of property associated with the use of Westside property or equipment.

ANIMALS

No dogs are allowed in the Clubhouse. Dogs on the course will be at heel or on a leash. Management has the right to request an animal be kenneled. During the summer we request the no dogs be allowed in the swimming pool.

OPERATION AND CLOSURES:

1. Hours of operation are Wednesday through Sunday during the **Spring/Summer Season:**

Westside closes promptly at the set time each day.

2. **Westside will be closed Mondays and Tuesdays** and may be closed on other days as posted from time to time for Events. Special situations for closing or operating hours will be posted.

GUESTS

1. Members are responsible for their guests in matters of finance, sportsmanship, safety and general conduct.
2. Guests are always welcome at Westside. Members are allowed to bring the same guest up to 4 times. Unaccompanied guests must be approved through the Manager and must be experienced in shooting. All guests and members must check in through the office before shooting the course.
3. Charges for guests are specified in the Fee Schedule.
4. Family members are not considered guests. Family members (includes spouse and dependent children) have full access to Westside and its activities. Parents and non-dependent children **are** considered guests.

SHOOTING RULES

1. All members and guests must sign in before shooting.
2. All shooters, trap personnel and spectators at all times on the course, must wear eye and ear protection.
2. When not on station, guns must be empty and the action open.
4. Only one shooter on station at a time.
5. Load only when on station and only after the shooting area is secure.
6. Keep loaded and unloaded guns pointed in a safe direction at all times.
7. Load a maximum of two shells in guns at any time.
8. Children must be under close supervision by adults at all times.
9. Place all trash, including empty hulls, in receptacles provided.
10. Pets on the course must be on a leash or at heel.
11. No alcohol or drugs prior to shooting. No alcohol will be permitted on the course at any time. This includes spectators.

CHARGES

1. All members are afforded open account billing as a service. This open account billing offering may be rescinded at any time and for any reason deemed appropriate.
2. Member's accounts will be mailed monthly and are payable not later than the end of the month of receipt.
3. Members having accounts in arrears twenty-five days or more from the statement date will be assessed a finance charge of 1.5% for each month in arrears.
4. Members having accounts in arrears ninety days or more are suspended.
5. All charges are the responsibility of the member. The Managers are the ONLY Westside staff members permitted to take payment from member or guests. Westside accepts cash, check, Visa or MasterCard.

FAMILY/INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP FEES

The Initiation fee is \$300 plus 6.25% sales tax.

Monthly Dues are \$125 plus 6.25% sales tax. This includes 250 targets to be used by the member during the month. Additional member targets are \$0.25 per target. Guest targets and any other charges are not included in the Monthly Dues. Guests may shoot 4 times. All shooting activity will be reflected on the Member's monthly billing and all Member charges are subject to 6.25% sales tax as prescribed for Waller County, Texas.

No Initiation refunds will be offered. Memberships are not transferable. A Membership includes immediate dependent family members only.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP FEES

4 Full Time Employee Minimum:

Initiation Fees: One time \$200 per named employee.

Monthly Dues are \$50 per employee.

Guests may shoot 4 times, per company.

The above Corporate Member's monthly billing will be sent directly to the corporation. A 6.25% sales tax as prescribed for Waller County, Texas will be applied.

Corporate members will keep a MasterCard or Visa on file and will pay as they shoot. Members will shoot for \$0.30 per target, pay the pickle.

No Initiation refunds will be offered. Memberships are not transferable. A Membership includes immediate dependent family members only.

OUT OF TOWN MEMBERSHIP FEES – OUTSIDE A +50 MILE RADIUS

The Initiation fee is \$300 plus 6.25% sales tax.

Monthly Dues are \$62.50 plus 6.25% sales tax. This includes 250 targets to be used by the member during the month. Additional member targets are \$0.25 per target. Guest targets and any other charges are not included in the Monthly Dues. Guests may shoot 4 times. All shooting activity will be reflected on the Member's monthly billing and all Member charges are subject to 6.25% sales tax as prescribed for Waller County, Texas.

No Initiation refunds will be offered. Memberships are not transferable. A Membership includes immediate dependent family members only.
